Whereas Learning to recognize the early warning signs of mental health needs and where to obtain the necessary support, assistance and treatment gives children and youth better opportunities to lead full and productive lives; and

Whereas The participation and partnership of family members in the assessment and treatment of children and youth is essential to positive outcomes; and

Whereas Children's Mental Health Week was developed by families of children with emotional, behavioral and mental health needs to focus on the needs of their children; and

Whereas In celebrating this year's theme, "Mental Health is Fundamental", it is fitting to increase public awareness among all Massachusetts citizens of this important issue,

Now, Therefore, I, Charles D. Baker, Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, do hereby proclaim the week of May 3rd to May 9th, 2015, to be,

And urge all the citizens of the Commonwealth to take cognizance of this event and participate fittingly in its observance.
